North Belfast offers a fantastic choice of walking trails for all levels of walkers, from the beginner to the experienced walker.

With its familiar outline visible from so many parts of the city, **Cavehill Country Park** is one of Belfast's most identifiable features. Said to have inspired Jonathon Swifts satirical novel, Gulliver's Travels, Cave Hill and its beautiful Park are every bit as inspiring today.



Why not spend a morning walking up Cavehill, or use the services of a guide to learn more about the history of the hill. On your return stop off at Belfast Castle's Cellar Restaurant for lunch. Renowned for its superb and wide ranging menu, using fresh local produce to create innovative and modern dishes, food is served in the warm yet historic ambiance of the cellar.

Once described by a guest as "the best kept secret in Northern Ireland." **The Cellar Restaurant** is open 7 days a week offering a wide variety of menus from morning coffee to full meals.



To continue your day exploring the treasures of North Belfast, take a **Taxi Tour** in one of the cities famous '**Black Cabs**'. Your driver will be happy to collect you at the Castle and you can choose to specify the areas you wish to see most, or leave the afternoon in the capable hands of your local guide.

After enjoying visits to some of North Belfast's most historic buildings and perhaps murals, ask you guide to drop you at **The Cathedral Quarter**, where you can end you day with a pint of Guinness in one of the area's **Traditional Irish pubs**.
